

Don's Legislative Priorities

Term Limits—Replace bad blood with new blood

- U.S. Senators 2 terms-total 12 years
- House of Representatives 4 terms-total 8 years
- Federal Judges:1 term-total 20 years

Congressional Compensation Reform

- Freeze previously promised benefits
- No pensions or lifetime healthcare benefit
- Salary + 401(k) with a up to 5% match
- No pay for congress or staff during any government shutdown

Anti-Corruption Enforcement

- Pre campaign FEC filings required that show candidate net worth
- Any net worth increase exceeding S&P 500 returns while in office triggers audit/clawback provisions
- Strict rules and prescribed penalties for insider trading

Healthcare Fairness

- No special healthcare plans for elected officials
- Medicare or open market health insurance only
- Provide a basic level of preventative care for all citizens with no copay to reduce catastrophic cost

Campaign Finance Reform

- Political Action Committees should be illegal to stop billionaires and corporations from buying election results
- Campaign spending should be capped
- Individual donations should be made to candidates, not parties

Immigration Reform

- Allow people who were able to enter the country by border control failure to remain IF they have a W2 or 1099 AND have no criminal record
- Use legal immigration to sensibly grow America's population to fill open jobs
- Pass laws to deport any non-citizen convicted of a felony or misdemeanor without right of appeal

Data Privacy

- Prescribed penalties for selling personal data without permission
- Extend HIPPA-like laws and rules to include personal data, including buying history, interests, driving records, mortgage and loan data, credit history, SSNs, and date of birth
- Make dark web operators and data brokers illegal
- Pass laws to stop the spam
